



Hospice and Community Care


The Allen Family Foundation

"We want to support the hospital because it supports the children of our employees, customers and everyone else in this community," says Peter Lustgarten who along with Stuart Lustgarten are the owners of Concordville Subaru. In 2022, the Foundation and the dealership continued its support of Nemours; and in the past, the dealership has supported major hospital expansion projects that allowed for single rooms for young patients and overnight accommodations. In addition to support from their Foundation account, the dealership supports Nemours over four long weekends during the year-President's Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, and Columbus Day-when the dealership pledges \$100 for every vehicle sold. The dealership has also helped make it possible for the hospital to receive nocost leases for two vehicles: a Subaru Outback and Subaru Tribeca from Subaru Corporation. The vehicles are used in the hospital's community outreach and trauma injury prevention programs.

Penn State Thon

The Motts Family Foundation

The Penn State Dance Marathon, or THON, is the largest student-run philanthropy in the world. THON is committed to enhancing the lives of children and families impacted by childhood cancer. The mission of Four Diamonds is to conquer childhood cancer by assisting children being treated at Penn State Children's Hospital and their families through superior care, comprehensive support, and

Children's Hospital and their families through superior care, comprehensive support, and innovative research. Any family with a child being treated for childhood cancer at Penn State Children's Hospital is eligible for support. Four Diamonds offsets the cost of treatment that insurance does not cover, as well as expenses that may disrupt the welfare of the child. Four Diamonds also supports the medical team that cares for the children and funds innovative pediatric cancer research through start-up grants and Four Diamonds Pediatric Cancer Research Institute. Comprised of over 16,500 Penn State student volunteers who aim to provide emotional and financial support to Four Diamonds families, at its most recent event over \$15 million was raised "For the Kids". In 2022, Penn State Thon received a generous contribution from The Motts Family Foundation.





The Barn at Spring Brook Farm

The Duke and Melissa Scott Family Foundation

The Barn at Spring Brook Farm began as the dream of Mary Beth Drobish in 2004 when she felt called to combine her passion for farm animals with her love for children. She believed that children with disabilities could benefit physically and psychologically from interactions with specially selected farm animals. The Barn was created as a fully handicapped-accessible facility so that children who might otherwise not be able to experience the complete range of farm experiences and involvement in animal care would be able to do so. The goal of the programs is to promote confidence, improve self-esteem, and support leadership qualities in children with disabilities ranging from physical disabilities to autism and Down Syndrome. In 2022, the Barn at Spring Brook Farm, located in West Chester, received a generous grant from the Duke and Melissa Scott Family Foundation.

Mew Coat Program - Operation Warm

The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation

This program began in 2008 with one simple mission: to provide brand-new winter coats to impoverished children in the five-county Philadelphia area. The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation challenges the dealer members of the Auto Dealers Association of Greater Philadelphia to join efforts to fill the need in their communities. The response is heartwarming and has grown each year. Since the program began, the foundation has given more than 575,000 new coats. In 2022, 58,239 coats were distributed through the School District of Philadelphia, Chester Upland School District, area YMCAs and dozens of non-profit organizations selected by participating dealerships to help get the new coats to local children who need them most.







Make-a-Wish Greater PA

The Earle M. Mitchell Memorial Foundation

The Earle M. Mitchell Memorial Foundation in 2022 gave generously to Make-a-Wish of Greater Pennsylvania and West Virginia. Their support of the Make-a-Wish foundation helped children like Landen. Diagnosed last year with a form of kidney cancer, it required chemotherapy so aggressive that it left Landen, 8, in terrible physical pain most days. With the help of the York County Regional Police Department Northeast District and a local judge, Landen – dressed in his uniform – was sworn in for the day. He spent it on patrol, explored a state police helicopter, and learned how to train a K9 officer. That night, Landen fell fast asleep – his new police hat askew on his head. In his hand, a tightly clutched police badge – badge number 100 – and in his pocket, fingerprint evidence: all cherished mementos from his wish come true.



Camelot for Children

The Greater Lehigh Valley Automobile Dealers Association Foundation

Camps and day programs at Camelot provide quality experiences for children with disabilities. Since 1987, volunteers have remodeled and furnished the house they purchased on Emmaus Avenue in Allentown, and Camelot has grown into a valuable asset for the community's children. Camelot's ten acre campus includes Yeager Fuel's splash pad, Abby's Attic outdoor playhouse, the Roger Worman Memorial Education Room, the American Bank Camelot Court, and a number of multi-purpose classrooms. Here, children have a safe place to learn and play. In 2022, Camelot for Children received a donation from the Greater Lehigh Valley Automobile Dealers Association Foundation. The GLVADA Foundation also gave to Family Promise, Love Ran Red, Volunteer Center of Lehigh Valley, Community Services for Children, Lehigh Valley Health Network, and Pediatric Cancer Foundation of the Lehigh Valley, among other generous grants.

Boy Scouts of America

The Joseph and Nancy Mycka Foundation

In 2022, the Joseph and Nancy Mycka Foundation gave to the Boy Scouts of America - Moraine Trails Council. The Moraine Trails Council supports Scouting programs in Southwest Pennsylvania. Their mission is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the

Scout Oath and Scout Law. In addition to the grant from their foundation, Joseph Mycka donates his time and talent as an adult leader of Troop 400 in Mars. The group averages about 30 boys ages 11 to 18. Actively involved in their community, the troop participates in local parades, Eagle projects, and outdoor adventure.





The Institute

The Paul K, and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation

The Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation in 2022 donated in support of The Institute's capital campaign to create a new nature center near Waynesboro. The Institute purchased a 40-acre rural property in Washington Township with plans to transform the property into a nature education center and living classroom for both students and the greater Waynesboro community. "It has been a privilege to watch the progress at The Institute's new nature and educational center, which provides for the study of climate, water resources, plants, and animals," Ken Shockey said. "It is a hands-on educational site for students, teachers and our community. We were happy to be asked to help The Institute." A one acre pond on The Institute's new property is home to a variety of wildlife, including a great blue heron.

Friends of Briar Brush

The Joseph and Mary Faulkner Family Foundation

Briar Bush Nature Center packs a great deal into only 12.5 acres in the midst of a residential neighborhood in Abington Township. It's a wonderful place for young children to get acquainted with the outdoors in a safe, contained environment. In a screened Butterfly House, kids can stand amid flying monarch and painted lady butterflies, and if they're lucky, get one to land on a shoulder. Briar Bush hosts numerous programs throughout the year for families and students. In 2022, Friends of Briar Brush received a generous grant from the Joseph and Mary Faulkner Family Foundation.

Cultural Alliance of York

The Giambalvo Family Foundation

Founded in 1999, Cultural Alliance's annual campaign powers arts organizations and artists that are essential to York's cultural soul. Over the last 23 years, Cultural Alliance of York has invested over \$13 million in cash and \$2.2 million in in-kind support for the arts. Funds raised benefit local artists and performances, arts education, and community events. In 2022, Cultural Alliance of York received a grant from the Giambalvo Family Foundation.



Warner Film Center at the Cascade

The Robert III and Joanne Preston Family Foundation

After six years of limited access, the historic Warner Cascade Theatre Museum and film center had a grand opening to the public in 2022, and the Robert III and Joanne Preston Family Foundation were generous supporters. Located in the heart of New Castle, The Cascade Picture Palace was the first theatre operated by the Warner Brothers in 1907. At the time, the Cascade Picture Palace was one of the first to feature real theatre seats and a permanent screen. The hand-crank projector displayed 7 minute episodes of the newly emerging feature films. Time moved on and so did the Warner Brothers -- Harry Warner moved to New York to handle their ever growing chain of palatial theaters, and Jack Warner to Hollywood to produce films and establish the WB studio. Today, the Warner Film Center serves as a museum and historic theatre paying homage to Warner Brothers.

The Fitchett Family Foundation

Located in Newtown, the Mid Atlantic Dance Theater and the Dance Ground school believe that knowledge of the arts is just as valuable as math, science and English. The arts are not only comprised of dancers, but of musicians, composers, actors/actresses and many more. The Nutcracker is performed by the Mid Atlantic Dance Theater, including area students and dancers from all over the country. In 2022, the Mid Atlantic Dance Theater received a grant from the Fitchett Family Foundation.



Reading Public Museum

The James M. Savage Foundation

For more than a century, the Reading Public Museum has been at the forefront of hands-on learning. Thanks to donations from its founder, Dr. Mengel, in 1904, and with nearly 2,000 pieces acquired at the St. Louis World's Fair, Reading students can see, touch, and learn about objects from around the globe. The centerpiece of this gallery is Nefrina, RPM's Ptolemaic period mummy, with original ornamented sarcophagus. In the decades that followed its opening, the Museum developed a world-class collection of more than 300,000 objects, including art, antiquities, and scientific and cultural artifacts from around the globe. In 2022, the Reading Public Museum received a grant from the James M. Savage Foundation.





Troops First

The Smail Family Foundation

Feherty's Troops First Foundation consists of four important initiatives that provide housing to wounded veterans and their families, establish valuable connections among service members to give them a critical support network in an effort to combat the veteran suicide crisis, coordinate a unique opportunity for service members to leave the battlefield on their own terms, and provide service dogs to assist in everyday life. Smail Auto Group has a long history of supporting Troops First, helping returned service men and women, who are transitioning out of the military after injuries sustained in combat. In 2022, Troops First received a generous grant from the Smail Family Foundation.



FOLDS of HONOR

The Roy V. Fund

Since 2007, Folds of Honor has provided life-changing scholarships to the spouses and children of America's fallen or disabled military. Over 44,000 scholarships have been awarded since 2007. Recently, their mission expanded to the families of America's first responders. 91% of donations go directly to scholarships and in 2022 the Roy V Fund generously donated to support their efforts.

Mew Hope Ministries

The Rolen E. and Patricia H. Ferris Foundation

In 2022, the Rolen E. and Patricia H. Ferris Foundation gave widely to support their community. A generous grant was made to New Hope Ministries, a Christian social service agency that shows the love and hope of Christ by serving neighbors in times of need and supporting their efforts toward stability. Their mobile food pantry visits areas in need and allows people in need to enter the custom trailer to access their food needs. In addition, the Rolen E. and Patricia H. Ferris Foundation gave to the Central PA Food Bank. Through these gifts, the Food Bank helped to feed over 135,000 people in need each month and reduce food scarcity in 27 counties.





Laurel House

The Three Little Angels Foundation

Laurel House is a comprehensive domestic violence agency serving individuals, families, and communities throughout Montgomery County. One in four women and one in seven men in the United States experience severe physical violence by an intimate partner during their lifetime. In addition to an emergency shelter, Laurel House offers a 24-hour hotline, transitional housing, a children's program, individual and group counseling, medical advocacy, legal representation, crisis response, law enforcement collaboration, and community education and prevention efforts. In 2022, Laurel House received a generous contribution from the Three Little Angels Foundation.

Crime Victim Center of Erie

The Matt and Karen Clark Family Foundation

In 2022, the The Crime Victim Center of Erie County received a grant from the Matt and Karen Clark Family Foundation. The Crime Victim Center was established in 1973 as the Erie County Rape Crisis Center, dedicated to assisting sexual assault victims, and in 1986 Victim Witness Services was established for victims of other violent crimes, their families and friends, and also to serve the witnesses to violent crimes. Matt and Karen have served as the hosts of the Center's major fundraising gala. It's through the dedicated efforts of sponsors, like Matt and Karen, that the Center can continue providing services completely free to victims of crime.

Heart of the Valley Animal Shelter

The Ballantine Family Charitable Fund

Animal shelters play a vital role in communities as they continuously work to reunite pets with their owners, shelter those in need and find new homes for animals that are lost, without a permanent home or for those animals that, for safety reasons, should not be roaming streets. In 2022, the Ballantine Family Charitable Fund donated to Heart of the Valley Animal Shelter. Heart of the Valley helps abandoned, abused and neglected animals. A committed staff works to educate the public to spay and neuter their pets and to spread awareness on pet adoption.




